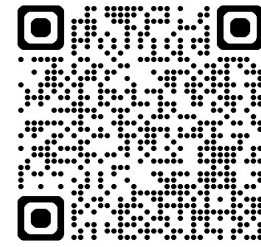

♀ Who should attend

- ◆ EHS Professionals.
- ◆ Shipping and Receiving personnel
- ◆ Persons who operate in the hazardous waste central accumulation area
- ◆ Persons who prepare or sign the uniform hazardous waste manifest or other shipping paper
- ◆ Persons who prepare a hazardous material (product or waste) for off-site transportation
- ◆ Supervisors and plant managers of personnel who perform any of the above functions

⇒ **USEPA requires initial and annual training for hazardous waste personnel of a hazardous waste large quantity generator at 40 CFR 262.17(a)(7).**

⇒ **USDOT requires initial and triennial training for HazMat Employees at 49 CFR 172.704(a).**
